2. Policy Statement

IMC will ensure that support is available to students to assist them with successfully completing their units and that students are made aware of these support services throughout their study.

Students At Risk of Not Successfully Completing Units

- (1) IMC will undertake the intervention strategy to identify students who are at risk of not successfully completing their units of study in accordance with *GU011 Intervention Strategies, Procedures and Guidelines.*
- (2) IMC will communicate with students identified as at risk to ensure they are aware of support services available to assist them in successfully completing their units of study.

Support Services Available to Students

- (3) IMC offers, either directly or through a third party, numerous support options for students to assist in the successful completion of their units of study, including:
 - a) Library services
 - b) Student wellbeing services, including but not limited to professional counselling services, career development, and student social activities.
 - c) Assessment guides
 - d) Academic literacy workshops
 - e) Academic English language support
 - f) Course advice and enrolment support
- (4) IMC will publish this *Support for Students Policy* as well as more information regarding support for students on its website and any other internal sites as deemed appropriate.
